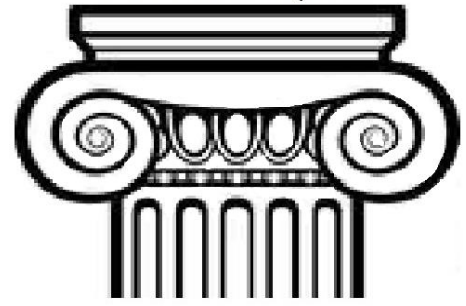

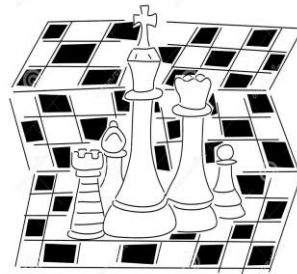
Dates: Camp 1 – June 11-15
