IFLY - PHYSICS & IPC

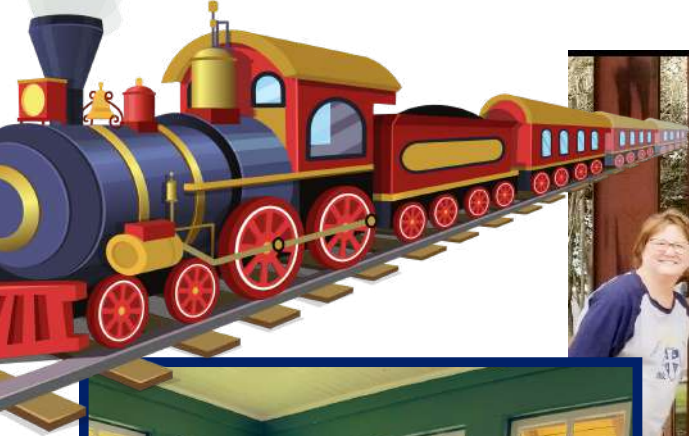
What an exhilarating day at iFLY for our students! Soaring through the air and experimenting with wind tunnel physics - a perfect blend of fun and learning!

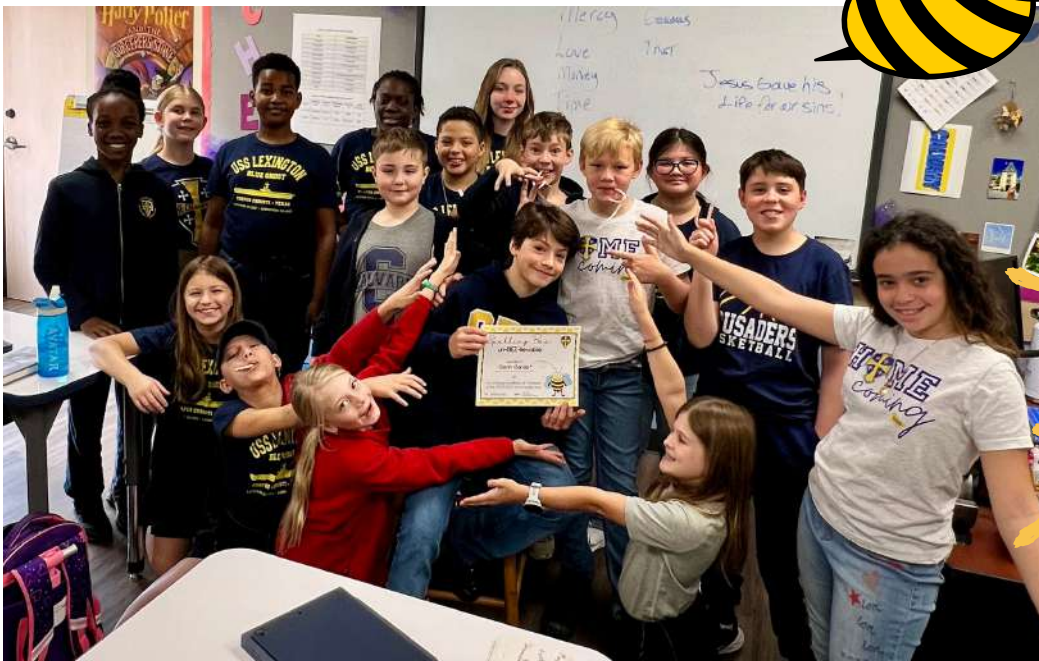


SPELLING BEE TRIUMPH!

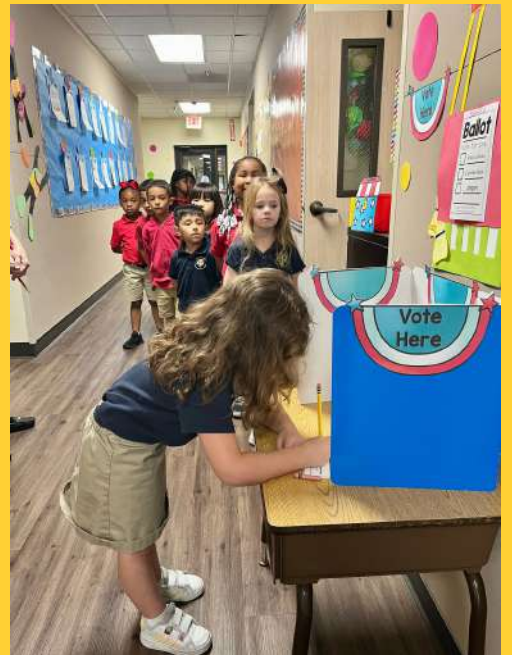
1ST GRADE NOTES OF THANKSGIVING

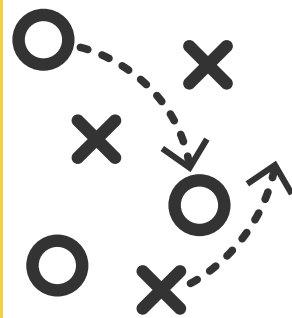
