Discounts

- Family Sibling Discount – full tuition for first child, each additional sibling receives 7% discount on tuition

Fees

All fees are non-refundable. All fees are added to tuition and collected at the time of contract signing.

Application Fee (New Students) \$1,000 paid with application

Returning Student Re-enrollment Fee \$500

International Student Service Fee Lower/Middle School \$450 - Technology, textbooks, class activity fee, yearbook, class picture, end of year testing and scoring, health services and various other items.

International Student Service Fee High School Fee \$1,400 - Technology, textbooks, class activity fee, yearbook, class picture, end of year testing and scoring, health services and various other items.

International Fee – Lower School \$2,400 – this fee includes all additional costs for an entire year of education. Examples: daily lunch, school supplies, all club fees, Tuesday breakfast fee, Annual Giving Campaign and various other items

International Fee – Middle School \$2,900 – this fee includes all additional costs for an entire year of education. Examples: daily lunch, school supplies, sports fees, all club fees, Tuesday breakfast fee, Annual Giving Campaign and various other items.

International Fee – High School \$4,300 – this fee includes all additional costs for an entire year of education. Examples: daily lunch, school supplies, sports fees, all club fees, Tuesday breakfast fee, Annual Giving Campaign, academic competitions, field trip travel expense and various other items.
