THESPIAN INDUCTIONS

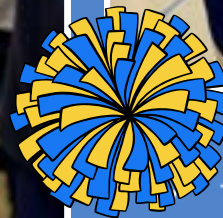
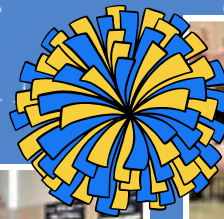
Calvary inducted 25 middle and high school Crusaders into the National Thespian Society! We are so proud of all of their hard work!

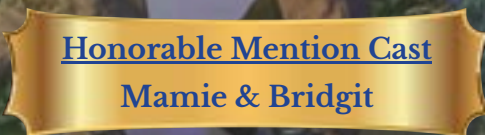

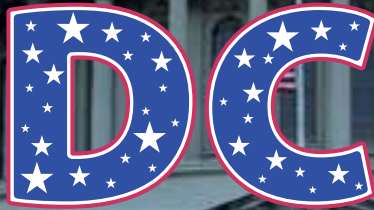

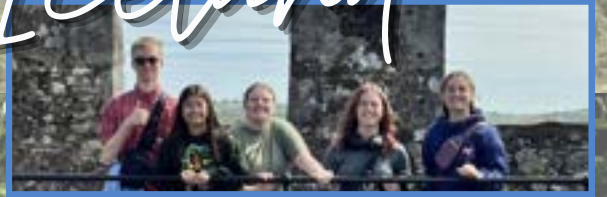
WASHINGTON, D.C. - 8th Grade

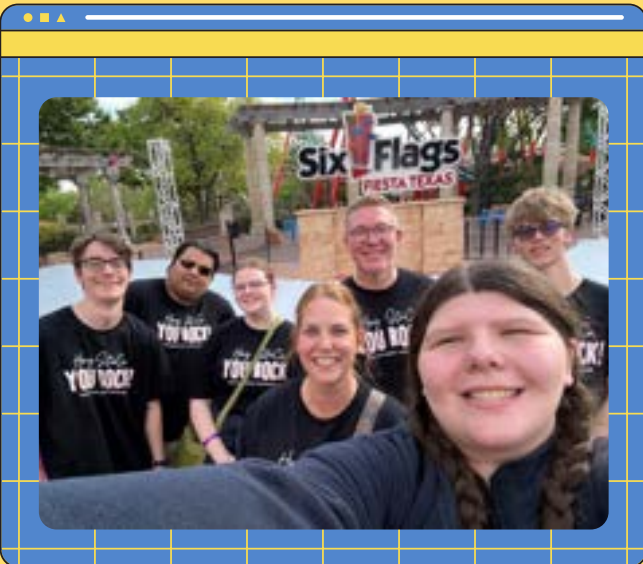
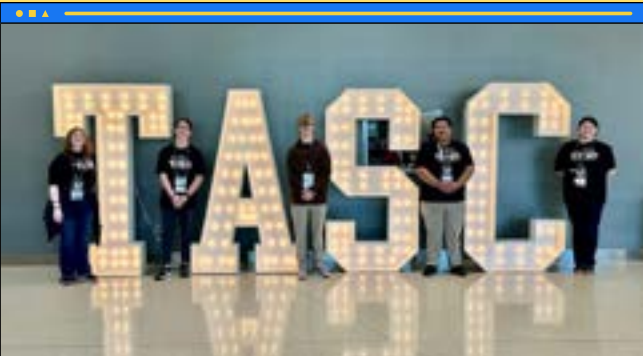
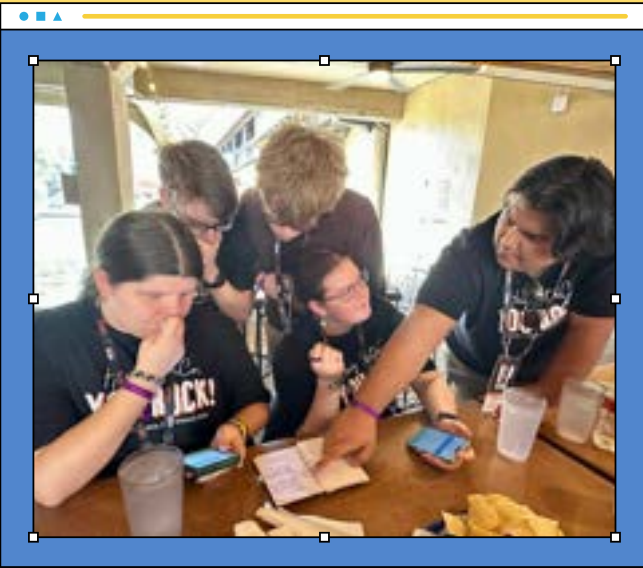


STUDENT COUNCIL STATE CONVENTION

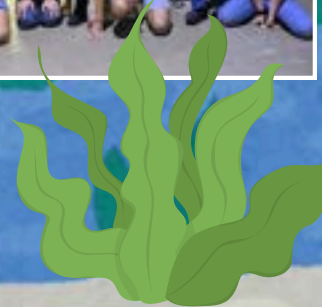
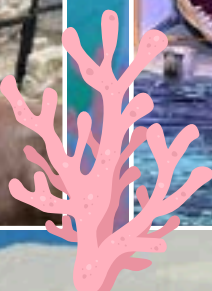
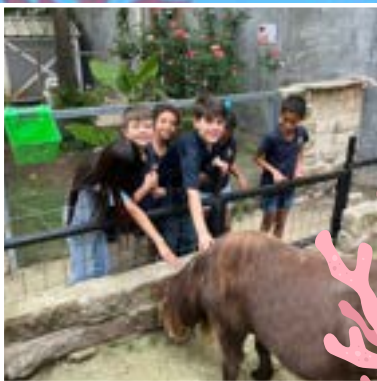
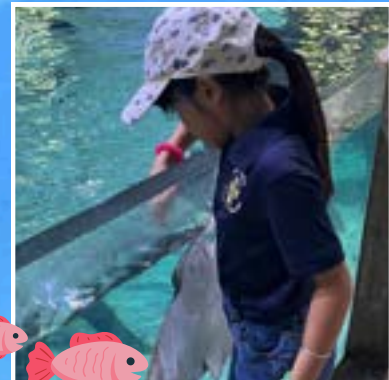
5th Grade USS Lexington

ARCHERY

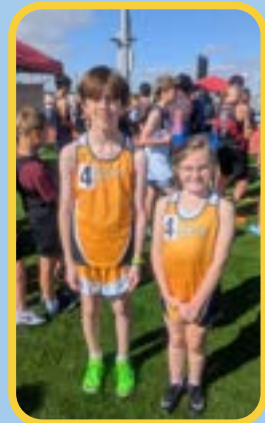

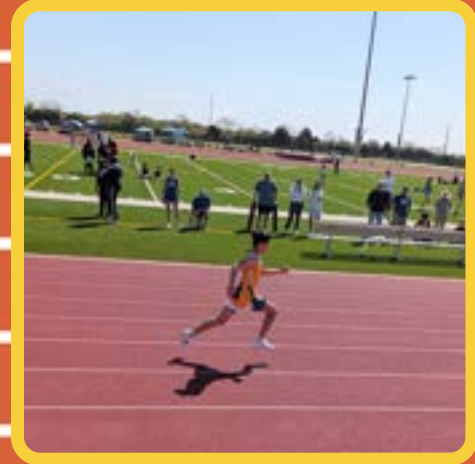

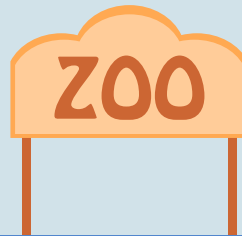
CINCO DE MAYO

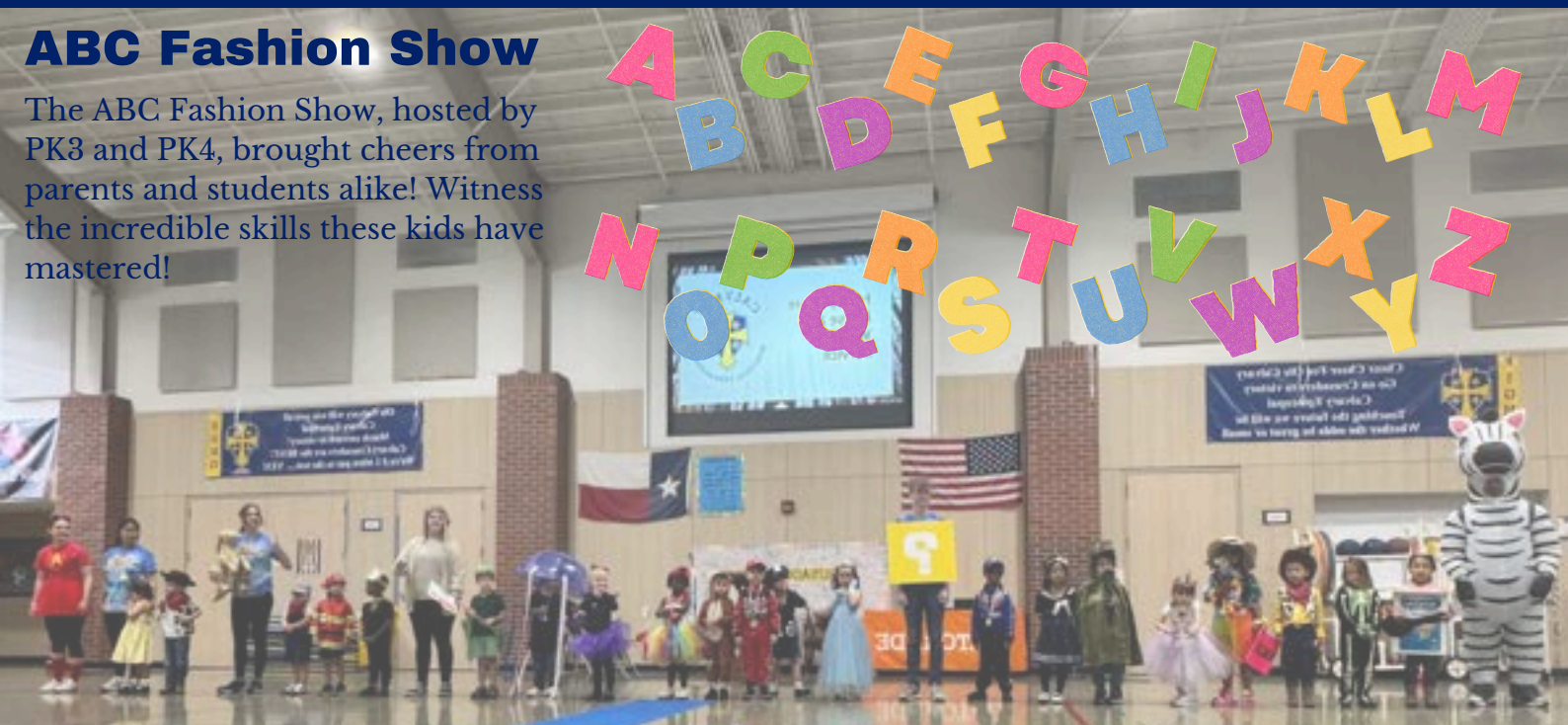
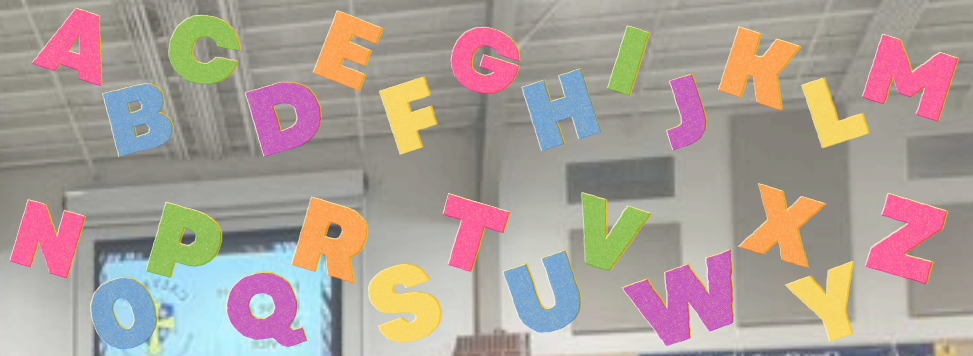
KINDERGARTEN ZOO
