DAILY UNIFORM



BOYS

TOPS:

- NAVY, LIGHT BLUE, OR GRAY POLOS WITH CEP LOGO
- SWEATSHIRTS OR JACKETS WORN INSIDE THE BUILDING MUST BE CEP

BOTTOMS:

- KHAKI OR NAVY BLUE PANTS OR SHORTS
- BLACK OR BROWN BELT REQUIRED

SHOES & SOCKS:

- SOLID BLACK AND/OR WHITE TENNIS SHOES
- NO HIGH TOP OR MID TOP SHOES
- SOLID BLACK OR WHITE SOCKS OF ANY HEIGHT
- ONLY SMALL LOGOS ALLOWED ON SOCKS

GIRLS

TOPS:

- NAVY, LIGHT BLUE, OR GRAY POLOS WITH CEP LOGO
- SWEATSHIRTS WORN INSIDE THE BUILDING MUST BE CEP

BOTTOMS:

- KHAKI PANTS, SHORTS, OR SKIRTS
- NAVY OR CALVARY PLAID SKIRTS
- BLACK OR BROWN BELTS REQUIRED WITH PANTS AND SHORTS
- NAVY BLUE MODESTY SHORTS MUST BE WORN UNDER SKIRTS

SHOES & SOCKS:

- SOLID BLACK AND/OR WHITE TENNIS SHOES
- NO HIGH TOP OR MID TOP SHOES
- WHITE SOCKS, KNEE HIGH SOCKS OR TIGHTS (NO LEGGINGS)
- ONLY SMALL LOGOS ALLOWED ON SOCKS

EXTRA

HAIR:

- FOR GIRLS, HAIR MUST BE NEATLY BRUSHED AND OUT OF EYES
- FOR BOYS, HAIR MUST BE CLEAN CUT, OUT OF EYES, AND OFF THE SHOULDER
- NO EXTREME COLORS IN HAIR

ACCESSORIES:

- ALL HAIR ACCESSORIES MUST BE NAVY, LIGHT BLUE, GRAY, GOLD, OR CALVARY PLAID

EXPECTATIONS:

- SHIRTS MUST BE TUCKED IN
- SKIRTS AND SHORTS MUST BE NO SHORTER THAN 2 INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE
- UNIFORM POLO MUST BE WORN UNDER SWEATSHIRTS
- HOODS OFF WHILE INSIDE

BOYS

TOPS:

- BLUE OXFORD SHIRT
- NAVY BLUE BLAZER WITH CEP LOGO
- NAVY BLUE TIE

BOTTOMS:

- KHAKI PANTS (NO SHORTS)
- BLACK OR BROWN BELT REQUIRED

SHOES & SOCKS:

- BLACK OR BROWN SOLID DRESS SHOES
- PLAIN TAN BOAT-STYLE SHOES
- SOLID BLACK OR WHITE SOCKS OF ANY HEIGHT
- NO LOGOS ON SOCKS ALLOWED

GIRLS

TOPS:

- WHITE OXFORD BLOUSE
- NAVY BLUE BLAZER WITH CEP LOGO
- NAVY BLUE TIE

BOTTOMS:

- KHAKI SKIRT
- NAVY MODESTY SHORTS

SHOES & SOCKS:

- BLACK DRESS SHOES
- NO SPARKLES OR COLORS
- HEELS MUST BE LESS THAN $\frac{1}{2}$ INCH
- SOLID WHITE SOCKS OF ANY HEIGHT
- NO LOGOS ON SOCKS ALLOWED

EXTRA

HAIR:

- FOR GIRLS, HAIR MUST BE NEATLY BRUSHED AND OUT OF EYES
- FOR BOYS, HAIR MUST BE CLEAN CUT, OUT OF EYES AND OFF THE SHOULDER
- NO EXTREME COLORS IN HAIR

- SKIRTS MUST BE NO SHORTER THAN 2 INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE



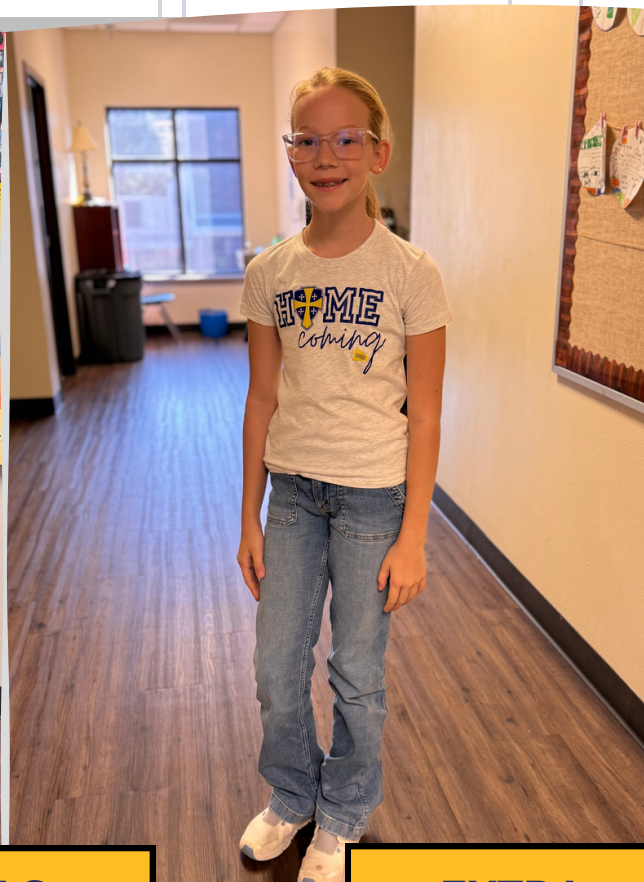

BOTTOMS:

- SOLID BLUE OR BLACK JEANS
- JEANS MAY NOT HAVE HOLES, TEARS/RIPS, PATTERNS, OR OTHER COLORS
- UNIFORM BOTTOMS
- BOTTOMS PURCHASED FROM THE SPIRIT STORE

SHOES & SOCKS:

- SOLID BLACK AND/OR WHITE TENNIS SHOES

BOYS

TOPS:

- SCHOOL-APPROPRIATE SHIRTS

BOTTOMS:

- SHORTS MUST NOT BE SHORTER THAN 2 INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE
- NO HOLES, TEARS, OR RIPS

SHOES & SOCKS:

- ANY CLOSED-TOE SHOES (MUST HAVE A BACK OR STRAP)
- NO LIGHTS OR WHEELS
- ANY SOCKS

GIRLS

TOPS:

- SCHOOL-APPROPRIATE SHIRTS
- NO TANK TOPS, TIGHT SHIRTS, OR CROP TOPS (NO SKIN SHOWING WHEN SITTING OR ARMS ARE RAISED)

BOTTOMS:

- SHORTS, SKIRTS, OR DRESSES MUST BE NO SHORTER THAN 2 INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE
- NO HOLES, TEARS, OR RIPS
- IF WEARING LEGGINGS, BOTTOM MUST BE COVERED WHEN ARMS ARE RAISED

SHOES & SOCKS:

- ANY CLOSED-TOE SHOES (MUST HAVE A BACK OR STRAP)
- NO LIGHTS OR WHEELS
- ANY SOCKS

EXTRA

HAIR:

- FOR GIRLS, HAIR MUST BE NEATLY BRUSHED AND OUT OF EYES
- FOR BOYS, HAIR MUST BE CLEAN CUT, OUT OF EYES, AND OFF THE SHOULDER
- NO EXTREME COLOR IN HAIR

ACCESSORIES:

- BOWS AND HEADBANDS OF ANY COLOR
- NO HATS, EARS, TINSEL, OR OTHER DISTRACTING ITEMS

UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS & CONSEQUENCES



SCHOOL UNIFORMS ARE PART OF OUR CULTURE OF EXCELLENCE. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES FOR EACH TYPE OF DRESS DAY. IF A STUDENT IS NOT IN PROPER UNIFORM, THE FOLLOWING CONSEQUENCES WILL APPLY:

DRESS UNIFORM DAYS

- Expectation: Students must wear all pieces of the official Dress Uniform.
- Consequence: If students are missing any required piece, they will be required to wear the full Dress Uniform every day for the following week.

DAILY UNIFORM

- Expectation: Students must wear the correct Daily Uniform pieces as outlined in the guide.
- Consequence: If out of uniform, students will lose the privilege of the next Free Dress/Spirit Dress Day and must wear the Daily Uniform instead.

SPIRIT DRESS

- Expectation: Students must follow the Spirit Dress guidelines (approved tops, uniform bottoms, etc.).
- Consequence: If out of compliance, students will lose the privilege of participating in the next Spirit Dress Day and must wear the Daily Uniform instead.

FREE DRESS

- Expectation: Students must follow Free Dress guidelines (modesty, safety, and school-appropriate attire).
- Consequence: If out of dress code, students will lose the privilege of participating in the next Free Dress Day and must wear the Daily Uniform instead.

If a student arrives out of dress code, parents will need to bring appropriate clothing so the student will be in compliance for the day. We appreciate your support in helping maintain a respectful and focused learning environment.
