BOYS

TOPS:

- NAVY, LIGHT BLUE, OR GRAY POLOS WITH CEP LOGO
- SWEATSHIRTS OR JACKETS WORN INSIDE THE BUILDING MUST BE CEP

BOTTOMS:

- KHAKI OR NAVY BLUE PANTS OR SHORTS
- BLACK OR BROWN BELT REQUIRED IN 1ST AND 2ND GRADE IF PANTS HAVE BELT LOOPS

SHOES & SOCKS:

- SOLID BLACK AND/OR WHITE TENNIS SHOES
- NO HIGH TOP OR MID TOP SHOES
- SOLID BLACK OR WHITE SOCKS OF ANY HEIGHT
- ONLY SMALL WHITE OR BLACK LOGOS ALLOWED ON SOCKS



GIRLS

TOPS:

- NAVY, LIGHT BLUE, OR GRAY POLOS WITH CEP LOGO
- POLO DRESSES WITH LOGO
- SWEATSHIRTS OR JACKETS WORN INSIDE THE BUILDING MUST BE CEP

BOTTOMS:

- KHAKI PANTS OR SHORTS
- KHAKI, PLAID, OR NAVY SKORT
- BLACK OR BROWN BELTS REQUIRED IN 1ST AND 2ND GRADE IF PANTS HAVE BELT LOOPS
- NAVY BLUE MODESTY SHORTS MUST BE WORN UNDER JUMPERS AND SKIRTS WITHOUT BUILT-IN SHORTS

SHOES & SOCKS:

- SOLID BLACK AND/OR WHITE TENNIS SHOES
- NO HIGH TOP OR MID TOP SHOES
- WHITE SOCKS, KNEE HIGH SOCKS OR TIGHTS (NO LEGGINGS)
- ONLY SMALL BLACK LOGOS ON SOCKS

EXTRA

HAIR:

- FOR GIRLS, HAIR MUST BE NEATLY BRUSHED AND OUT OF EYES
- FOR BOYS, HAIR MUST BE CLEAN CUT, OUT OF EYES, AND OFF THE SHOULDER
- NO EXTREME COLORS IN HAIR

BOYS

TOPS:

- BLUE OXFORD SHIRT
- NAVY BLUE SWEATER VEST WITH CEP LOGO
- NAVY BLUE TIE

BOTTOMS:

- KHAKI PANTS (NO SHORTS)
- BLACK OR BROWN BELT REQUIRED IN 1ST AND 2ND GRADE IF PANTS HAVE BELT LOOPS

SHOES & SOCKS:

- SOLID BLACK OR BROWN DRESS SHOES
- PLAIN TAN BOAT-STYLE SHOES
- SOLID WHITE OR BLACK SOCKS OF ANY HEIGHT
- NO LOGOS ON SOCKS ALLOWED

GIRLS

DRESS:

- WHITE PETER PAN COLLAR BLOUSE
- CALVARY PLAID JUMPER WITH CEP LOGO
- NAVY MODESTY SHORTS

SHOES & SOCKS:

- SOLID BLACK FLAT DRESS SHOES
- PLAIN TAN BOAT-STYLE SHOES
- NO SPARKLES, COLORS, OR HEELS ON SHOES
- WHITE SOCKS, KNEE HIGHS, OR TIGHTS (NO LEGGINGS)
- NO LOGOS ON SOCKS ALLOWED

EXTRA

HAIR:

TOPS:

BOTTOMS:

SHOES & SOCKS:

- ANY CLOSED-TOE SHOES (MUST HAVE A BACK OR STRAP)
- NO LIGHTS OR WHEELS
- ANY SOCKS

GIRLS

TOPS:

- SCHOOL-APPROPRIATE SHIRTS
- NO TANK TOPS, TIGHT SHIRTS, OR CROP TOPS (NO SKIN SHOWING WHEN SITTING OR ARMS ARE RAISED)

BOTTOMS:

- SHORTS, SKIRTS, SKORTS, OR DRESSES MUST BE NO SHORTER THAN 2 INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE
- NO HOLES, TEARS, OR RIPS
- IF WEARING LEGGINGS, BOTTOM MUST BE COVERED WHEN ARMS ARE RAISED

SHOES & SOCKS:

- ANY CLOSED-TOE SHOES (MUST HAVE A BACK OR STRAP)
- NO LIGHTS OR WHEELS

HAIR:

- FOR GIRLS, HAIR MUST BE NEATLY BRUSHED AND OUT OF EYES

Focus on Learning

When Calvary students wear appropriate, comfortable, and non-distracting attire, the focus remains on instruction and learning, not on clothing. It reduces potential distractions among peers and helps maintain a professional atmosphere, even at this young age.

Fostering Good Habits and School Pride

Adhering to a dress code teaches our young learners responsibility and the importance of following rules and expectations—skills that are essential for future success. It also promotes a sense of unity and Calvary school pride among the student body.

Fairness and Equality

A dress code helps minimize socioeconomic differences and peer pressure related to fashion trends. When all Calvary students dress similarly, it supports an environment of equity and allows students to express their individuality through their work and personality, not just their clothes.

We understand mornings can be challenging, but your cooperation is essential:

1. Review the Guidelines: Please review the official Calvary dress code document for PK3–2nd grade regarding tops, bottoms, shoes, and accessories.
2. Teacher Messaging: If your child arrives out of compliance, the teacher will send a private message or note home indicating the specific item. Please ensure your child is in compliance the following day.
3. Immediate Compliance: If a student is out of dress uniform dress code, we will call parents to bring appropriate clothing so the student will be in compliance for the remainder of the school day.
